The Faculty of Political Science at the University of Sarajevo welcomes applications from potential exchange scholars and staff.

Application requirements:

- (i) CV
- (ii) Statement of Purpose (500 words)
- (iii) Lecture Topics/Work Plan (500 words)

<u>Statement of Purpose</u>: Candidates are required to provide information on their affiliation and status, mobility program through which they are applying, period of stay (including dates of arrival and departure) and scholarship (type and provider). Rest of the document is reserved for information about motives, reasons, objectives and benefits of the mobility for both the candidate and host institution (Faculty of Political Science).

<u>Lecture Topics</u>: Candidates applying for *teaching mobility* are required to submit a list and brief description of three (3) lectures to be delivered at the Faculty of Political Science in Sarajevo.

<u>Work Plan</u>: Candidates applying for *research* stay are required to submit a Work Plan outlining their research project. Candidates applying for *training mobility* are required to submit a Work Plan outlining their training project.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Decisions will be made within seven (7) working days upon the receipt of a complete application.

Note: We stronly suggest that applications of prospective exchange scholars and staff to Faculty of Political Science should be submitted at least seven (7) days before the deadline of Call for Applications of respective mobility programs (for teaching/traning/reasearch scholarships). We are fully aware that candidates require Invitation Letter or Letter of Intent from their host institutions in order to apply for mobility programs, but to obtain it candidates must submit application as described in the text above.

Applications submitted 48 hours or less before closing of the deadline for respective mobility programs Call for Applications will not be taken for consideration.
