Call for applications for summer semester 2018

Call for applications for students of the Faculty of Political Science University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) to participate in the Erasmus+ student mobility program at the University of Salzburg.

University of Salzburg is happy to announce the start of Erasmus+ project that will allow students of the Faculty of Political Science University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) to spend summer semester 2018 at the University of Salzburg.

The call for applications is open from 18 October to 1 November 2017 for the summer semester of academic year 2017/2018. The results of the nomination process will be announced not later than 5 November 2017.

Eligibility:

All BA and MA and students from the Faculty of Political Science University of Sarajevo. The Inter-Institutional Agreement between University of Salzburg and Faculty of Political Science at the University of Sarajevo provides 4 scholarships for BA and MA students.

Placements in BA Political Science require at least German passive as language competences in the mostly German taught courses (oral statements and papers can be given in English). BA students have the opportunity to continue as MA students in the joint MA program of University of Sarajevo and Salzburg (PoSIG) after completion of their BA. PoSIG grants for one year will be given to successful applicants (www.euro-ps.org and www.facebook.com/PoSIG will open the next call for PoSIG in March 2018).

Placements in MA Political Science only require English B2 and a BA in Political Science or International Relations.

Application procedure:

All applications are reviewed by the Erasmus Selection Committee at the Faculty of Political Science at the University of Sarajevo. Applicants for

placements in BA Political Science will be invited for a short interview to determine passive knowledge of German language.

Required application documentation:

- Motivation letter (max. 500 words)
- A transcript of academic records
- Latest CV

All required documents must be in English with the exception of Transcript of Records that can be submitted in local language.
