BA students prioritized.

# **Eligibility:**

The priority is to BA students of Political Science from the Faculty of Political Sciences, University of Sarajevo. However, MA students can also apply.

- A transcript of academic records
- Latest CV (Europass)

University of Salzburg expect all applicants to have English skills at B2 level, German language skills are an additional asset. Applicants at Master's level should have a BA degree in Political Science or International Relations. Experience with the PoSIG call 2022 showed that it can be beneficial to MA applicants to have previous study experience as a BA exchange student in Salzburg.
