## **Eligibility and Profile**

We encourage **motivated students and recent graduates** of Public policy, Political Science, International Relations, Media Studies to apply. Graduates in other fields who have demonstrated an interest in public policy may also be accepted.

All candidates must be able to:

- Meet strict deadlines while providing quality content.

- Speak fluent English, with excellent written skills.

- Demonstrate **strong analytical capacity** and ability to **discern policy issues**.

- Show willingness to learn and cooperate.

Previous experience is a plus, but not necessary.

## **Internship Description**

- The internships will last **5 months**.

- All internships are completely **home-based** (online).

- Selected candidate's primary **task** will be supporting the Politheor.net **op-ed section** by writing one policy-related op-ed of 700-1000 words per month.

- Politheor internships are an educative and professional experience, therefore, interns will receive extensive **training and instructions** in writing op-eds. This training combined with the overall experience will prove useful in future careers.

- The internship is suitable for students whom are required to complete an internship as an integral part of their studies. We are occasionally able to make arrangements in order to assure school requirements are met, but be sure to check with one of the Politheor staff before beginning your application.
