

## **Erasmus+ Student Mobility**

### **Call for applications for 2016/2017 academic year**

**Call for applications from students of the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina)<sup>1</sup> to participate in the Erasmus+ student mobility at the International Institute of Social Studies of the Erasmus University Rotterdam (Netherlands)<sup>2</sup>**

The International Institute of Social Studies (ISS) of Erasmus University Rotterdam is happy to announce the Erasmus + Student Mobility Fund that will allow students of the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) to spend time at the ISS. The program is fully funded by Erasmus + funds.

The call is open for applications from 15 March to 15 June 2016, for the academic year 2016/2017 (September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017). The results of the application will be announced around July 10, 2016.

#### **Eligibility:**

All MA and PhD students of the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo.

#### **Conditions:**

MA students can apply for a semester (3 - 4.5 months) and PhD students can apply for a stay up to 6 months at the ISS.

All MA students visiting ISS must enrol in one of the ISS MA courses. PhD students are allowed to register to any of the ISS PhD courses (if applicable). Both host and home institutions are obliged to respect Erasmus+ rules on exchange of educational credits for MA (and if applicable, PhD) students. ISS will provide the necessary conditions for realizing the educational and research plans of the MA and PhD students from the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo.

ISS will receive up to 14 MA and 6 PhD students from the University of Sarajevo.

#### **Financial compensation:**

Students will receive a monthly allowance of €850 and a travel grant depending on the travel distance:

- between 500 and 1999 km      €275

#### **Application procedure:**

All applications are reviewed first by the Selection Committee of the home institution, who then sends a proposal to the host institution's Selection Committee. The host institution's Selection Committee makes the final decision on the list of successful applicants. The list of the successful applicants will be forwarded to the EUR International Office that will take up further contact with the applicants and deal with all logistical issues (visa's, finances, etc.).

**Selection criteria:**

- Quality of the candidate;
- Quality of the proposed plan for the mobility activities and the potential benefits of the mobility for the candidate and the institution;

**Application documentation:**

- A substantiating motivation letter explaining the benefits of the proposed mobility and chosen educational/research programme for the candidate ([for information about courses at the ISS click here](#));
- A letter of permission from the programme director or examination board of the home institution. Both home and host institution have to agree on the suitability of the course/research activities for the student;
- Two letters of recommendation;
- Appropriate pass level on the IETLS or TOEFL, or other appropriate proof of English language proficiency;
- A transcript of academic records;
- A letter of acceptance into the research group from a tutor at the host university if the mobility is for research purposes;

## **Erasmus+ Staff Mobility**

### **Call for applications for 2016/2017 academic year**

**Call for applications from staff of the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) <sup>3</sup> and the International Institute of Social Studies of the Erasmus University Rotterdam (Netherlands)<sup>4</sup> to participate in the Erasmus+ staff mobility program.**

The International Institute of Social Studies (ISS) of Erasmus University Rotterdam is happy to announce the Erasmus + Staff Mobility Fund that will allow its staff and that staff of the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo (Bosnia & Herzegovina) to spend time teaching and training at each other's institutions. The program is fully funded by Erasmus + funds.

The call is open for applications from 15 March to 15 June 2016, for the academic year 2016/2017 (September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017). The results of the application will be announced around July 10, 2016.

#### **Eligibility:**

All academic and administrative staff from the Faculty of Political Science, University of Sarajevo as well as all ISS academic and administrative staff.

#### **Conditions:**

Academic staff can apply for 5-8 days stay at each other's institutions; administrative staff can apply for up to 5 days training.

All host institutions will provide necessary conditions for the realization of teaching and training plans of the academic and administrative staff.

ISS will receive up to 12 staff for teaching (60 days, excluding travel) and 2 for training (10 days, excluding travel) from the University of Sarajevo.

ISS will send up to 10 staff for teaching (50 days, excluding travel) and 2 staff for training (10 days, excluding travel) to the University of Sarajevo

#### **Financial compensation:**

Staff will receive a daily allowance of €160 and a travel grant depending on the travel distance:

- between 500 and 1999 km      €275

#### **Application procedure:**

All applications are reviewed first by the Selection Committee of the home institution, who then sends a proposal to the host institution's Selection Committee. The host institution's Selection Committee makes the final decision on the list of successful applicants. The list of

the successful applicants will be forwarded to the EUR International Office that will take up further contact with the applicants and deal with all logistical issues (visa's, finances, etc.).

**Selection criteria:**

- Quality of the candidate;
- Quality of the proposed plan for the mobility activities and the potential benefits of the mobility for the candidate and the institution;

**Application documentation:**

- A substantiating motivation letter explaining the benefits of the proposed mobility programme for the candidate and the institution, with a proposal for lecture(s) the staff could teach at the host institutions;
- A letter of permission from the programme director of the home institutions. Both home and host institution have to agree with the suitability of the teaching and training activities for the academic and administrative staff;
- Appropriate pass level on the IETLS or TOEFL, or other appropriate proof of English language proficiency;
- Candidate's CV and publishing record;

Applications should be submitted until 15 June 2016 to the contact person from the home institution.
